Hello dear students! Grab your explorer hat and get ready for a summer vacations full of discovery, fun and learning with nature all around you. Let's explore the amazing world of plants, birds and explore new places!

TASK 1: Nature Walk and Leaf Collection to make a Herbarium.

A nature walk helps us to explore and learn about plants around us. To make your nature walk memorable, collect a variety of leaves and use them to create a beautiful herbarium (A herbarium is a collection of dried and preserved leaves).

The steps to prepare the herbarium are given below-

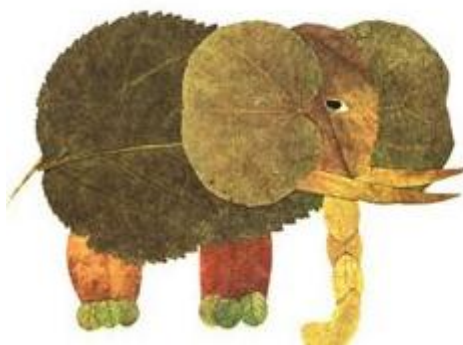
- Collect 8 to 10 different types of leaves.
- Place the leaves between sheets of newspaper or blotting paper.
- Put the paper inside a thick book.
- Leave the leaves to dry for 5–7 days.
- Check if the leaves are dry and crisp.
- Once dried, use them for your herbarium.

For each leaf write the name of the plant, place and date of collection.



TASK 2: Leaf Art-Make Animals.

Use dried leaves to creatively make two birds or animals using your imagination. Write the name of each one. Then, find and write any four fascinating facts about each animal. Samples are shared below.



SOCIAL STUDIES

Task 1: Paper Tearing Art – Wonders of the World

Where to do: Take a print of the outline image on an A3 size sheet or you may draw it also.

Steps to follow:

- Create the outline image (as also given in the sample images) of the *Wonder of the World* as per your roll-number allotment, using paper tearing and pasting (you may also use soft thread for outlining).
- Write the name of the site clearly at the top.

COMPUTER

Task 1: My Digital Wonder Scrapbook

Topic: Wonders Around Us (Nature & Buildings)

Software: MS Word (Laptop) or Google Docs App (Mobile)

The Project: A 4-Block Wonder Page

Students will create a grid that shows 4 different wonders: 2 from Nature (like Mount Everest) and 2 made by Humans (like the Great Wall of China).

Steps to follow:

- Create a Cool Title (WordArt)

Open a new MS Word document.

Skill: Go to the Insert tab and click on WordArt.

Pick a wavy or colorful style. Type: "Wonders of the World".

Drag it to the top center of your page.

- Make a Grid (Using Tables)

Skill: Go to Insert -> Table.

Move your mouse to select 2x2 squares (2 columns and 2 rows).

Click to drop the table. Now you have 4 big boxes to fill!

- Fill the Boxes (Images)

Click inside the first box.

Skill: Go to Insert -> Online Pictures.

Search for a wonder (e.g., "Northern Lights" or "Taj Mahal").

Press Insert. If the picture is too big, grab the corner dot and push it in to make it fit inside the box.

- Add Captions (Writing)

Click below the picture in the same box.

Type the name and the country (e.g., "Pyramids - Egypt").

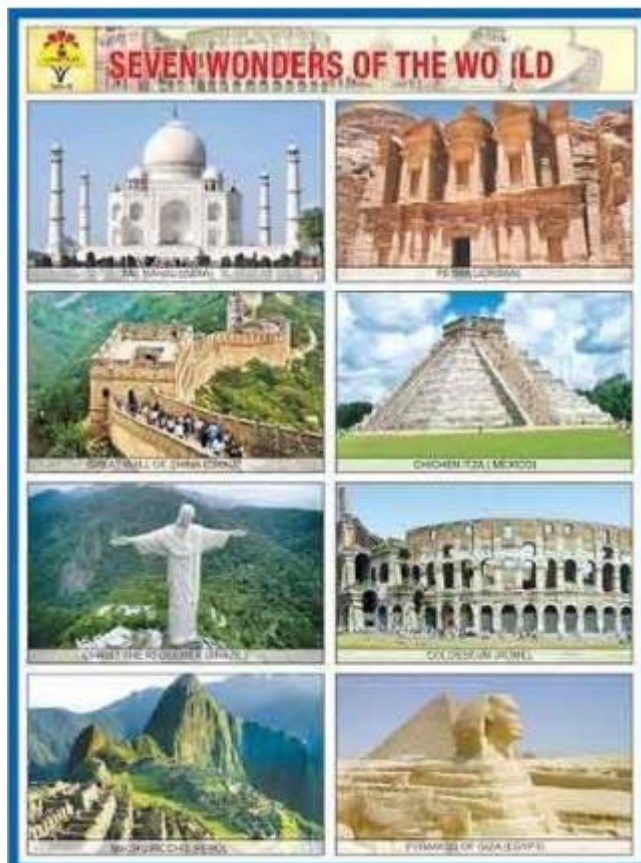
Skill: Use the Center button (Home tab) to make the text sit nicely under the photo.

- Add a Border (Final Touch)

Skill: Go to the Design tab and click Page Borders.

Choose a "Box" border. If you want to be fancy, look at the "Art" dropdown menu and pick stars, trees, or globes!

Task 2: Leaf Rubbing – See the Veins of a Leaf

Place a leaf under a white paper. Gently rub a crayon or pencil over the paper. The veins and texture of the leaf will appear on the paper like magic.

What we learn: Leaf veins carry water and food through the plant. This simple activity helps us see the hidden beauty of nature.
