What to include:

- Slogans (e.g., “Love animals”, “They share our planet”)

MATHEMATICS

Activity 1: Before – After – Restore (Flip Page)

Instructions: Take a scrapbook page and make three flaps using coloured paper.

Write on the flaps:

Before War , After War , After Restoration

Under each flap draw pictures showing:

1.A healthy forest

2.Trees destroyed during war

3.People planting trees

Write a math equation related to the number of trees.

Example: Before war = 80 trees Trees cut = 30

$$80 - 30 = 50 \text{ trees left. Trees planted later} = 20 ; 50 + 20 = 70 \text{ trees}$$

Activity 2: Story Collage with Maths

Instructions: Divide your scrapbook page into 4 parts.

Draw or paste pictures showing:

1.A beautiful forest

2.War destroying nature

3.People planting trees

4.Nature becoming green again.

Write 3–4 lines of a short story.

Add 2 addition sums and 1 fraction problem related to your story.

Example:

Trees planted = 40

More trees planted = 20 ; $40 + 20 = 60$ trees

Fraction:

Total animals = 16

$\frac{1}{4}$ animals were saved

$16 \div 4 = 4$ animals saved

Computer Nature vs. War (Digital Storytelling)

Software: Google Slides (Laptop) or Canva/PowerPoint App (Mobile)

The Project: "The Healing Earth"

Your task is to create a small digital presentation (3-4 slides) that shows how nature is beautiful and how we must protect it from the damage of war.

Step-by-Step Instructions:

Slide 1: The Beauty of Nature

Task: Find a beautiful picture of a forest or a clean ocean on the internet.

Skill: Use Insert > Image > Search the web.

Text: Type a title: "Nature is Peaceful."

Slide 2: The Impact of War (The "Grey" Side)

Task: Find a picture showing a "Dry Land" or "Broken Buildings."

Skill: Change the Image Filter to "Greyscale" or "Black and White" using the picture formatting tools. This shows that war takes away the colors of life.

Text: Type: "War hurts the Earth."

Slide 3: Nature Wins (The Recovery)

Task: Find a picture of a small flower growing through a crack in a wall or a road.

Skill: Use the Crop Tool to focus only on the flower.

Text: Type: "Nature always tries to grow back."

Slide 4: My Digital Pledge

Task: Use the Shape Tool to draw a "Green Heart" or a "Peace Sign" (\text{☸}).

Text: Type one way you can help the planet (e.g., "I will plant a tree" or "I will use less plastic")
